### MODEL T MUSEUM ROAD TRIP REDUX

This month we will try once again to head to Richmond and a return visit to the model T museum. Hopefully they won't try to burn down the city again. It's been a number of years since we were last there and they have greatly expanded their collection. As you can see from the facility layout, they now have 2 buildings and several themed displays. The Model T Ford Club of America was organized in late 1965 for the purpose of bringing together people who are interested in the Model T Ford, its history, its evolution, and its place in the American scene. The Model T Ford Club of America is the largest Model T club in the world. Over one hundred chapters have been formed in the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia, New Zealand, and South America providing activities and fellowship for Model T enthusiasts on the local level. We have a tour scheduled by their staff at 11 a.m.

We will gather at the south end of the Home Depot parking lot at 9:45 a.m. on Saturday the 20th. There will be ample space available if you do not want to drive yourself. We'll travel over on I-70 and should be there by 10:45, if you would want to meet us there. After the tour, we will have lunch at the Firehouse BBQ restaurant across the street from the museum. If it's a nice day, why not get the 'Bird out and give it a run.


Here are directions to their museum:


### From I-70 and US HWY 35

### From US Route 40

Turn north onto US 27/N. 9th St. Immediately before the bridge, turn left on North D Street. Turn left into the public parking lot.
